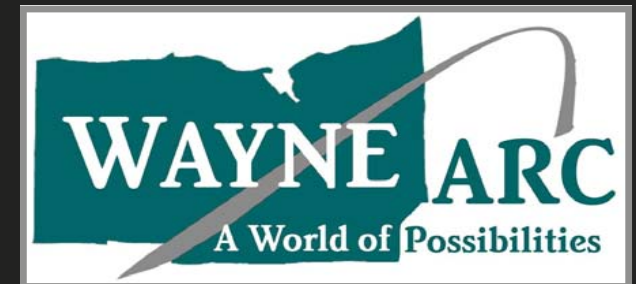

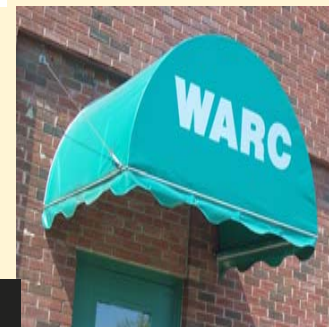

programs & services

Central Intake

The Central Intake Department receives inquiries and requests for services. The Intake staff will evaluate each person's needs, establish eligibility, and connect them with the appropriate programs and services.

Roosevelt Children's Center

Provides a variety of Educational and Clinical Services to children and their families, ages birth to 5 years. Our clinicians provide services at our facility, day cares, at home or Headstart programs. Roosevelt Children's Center is also a licensed Day Care program for children ages 18 months to 5 years.

Clinical Services

Provides a wide range of clinical services in dietary, psychology, nursing, social work, occupational, physical, and speech therapy. In addition medical assessment for guardianship, dementia screening and medical consent issues are also offered. Services are available at both our Newark site and our satellite site in Albion.

Residential Services

Offers a variety of housing options to people with developmental disabilities. Within each residential program, whether it be a 24 hour staff supervised home or a supported apartment, staff offer training and assistance with day to day living skills. Our goal is to support and guide individuals while they strive for independence and inclusion into our Wayne County communities.

Vocational Services

Key Industries provides vocational rehabilitation services to people with disabilities. These vocational services consist of evaluation, skill training, career counseling, job placement, job coaching, work experience for transitioning students and supports on the job. Employment opportunities include center based and community placement, in individual or group settings. Our goal is to assist people with disabilities in finding employment that is compatible with their abilities, interests and resources.

OPTS Transportation

Wayne ARC provides transportation services for individuals with developmental disabilities who live independently in the community. Transportation is provided to a variety of locations including grocery stores, malls, recreational events and visits to see families and friends. This service is provided to eligible individuals on a daily basis, including evenings and weekends.

Service Coordination

Provides support, linkage and referral to obtain quality services assisting individuals in becoming as independent as possible. An emphasis is placed on empowering people to make informed choices and to determine their personal goals. Service Coordinators meet with individuals monthly to monitor and to ensure satisfaction of services provided. Service Coordinators assist with accessing services.

Day Habilitation

The Day Habilitation Program focuses on providing services to increase, enhance and/or maintain daily living skills, social skills and health & safety skills. We assist individuals to develop house-keeping, personal care and money management skills. Recreational activities are offered on a daily basis. We provide numerous and diverse community inclusion opportunities. Our goal is to promote independence and productivity in each person. All services are individualized. Our recently renovated Alzheimer's area serves those people who require a higher level of care. Activities are designed to maintain and to promote the highest possible level of physical, mental and psychological well being for each participant.

Community Services

Provides support to families caring for a disabled family member in their home through a variety of programs including residential habilitation, recreation, respite, homemaker services, family reimbursement, crisis intervention. and budgeting.

Guardianship

Wayne ARC provides information on how to become a legally appointed guardian of a developmentally disabled person to assist them with managing their affairs. Wayne ARC also represents the New York State ARC as legal guardian of developmentally disabled individuals when other options are not available.
